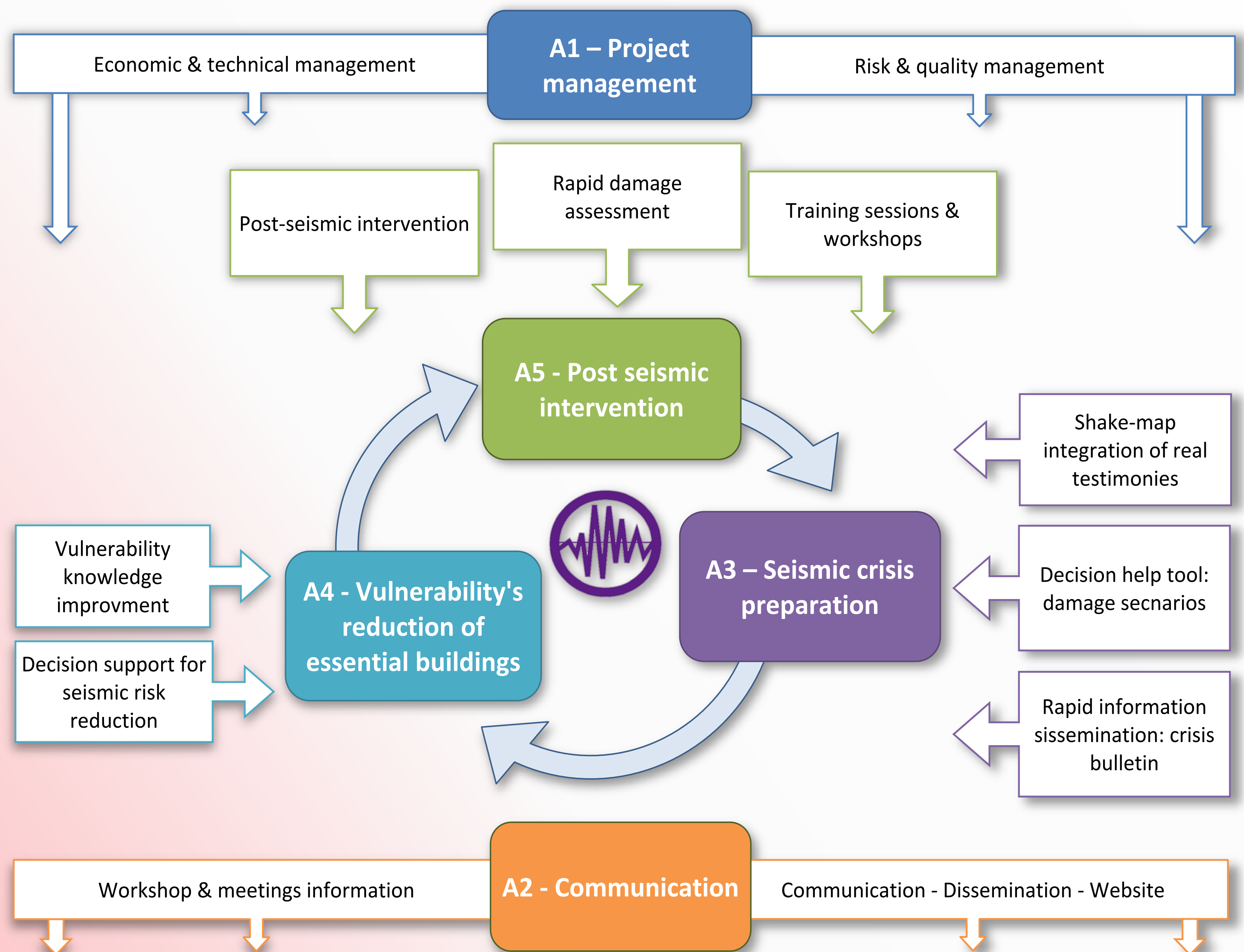


POCRISC: toward a common culture of seismic risk in the Pyrenees



Objectives

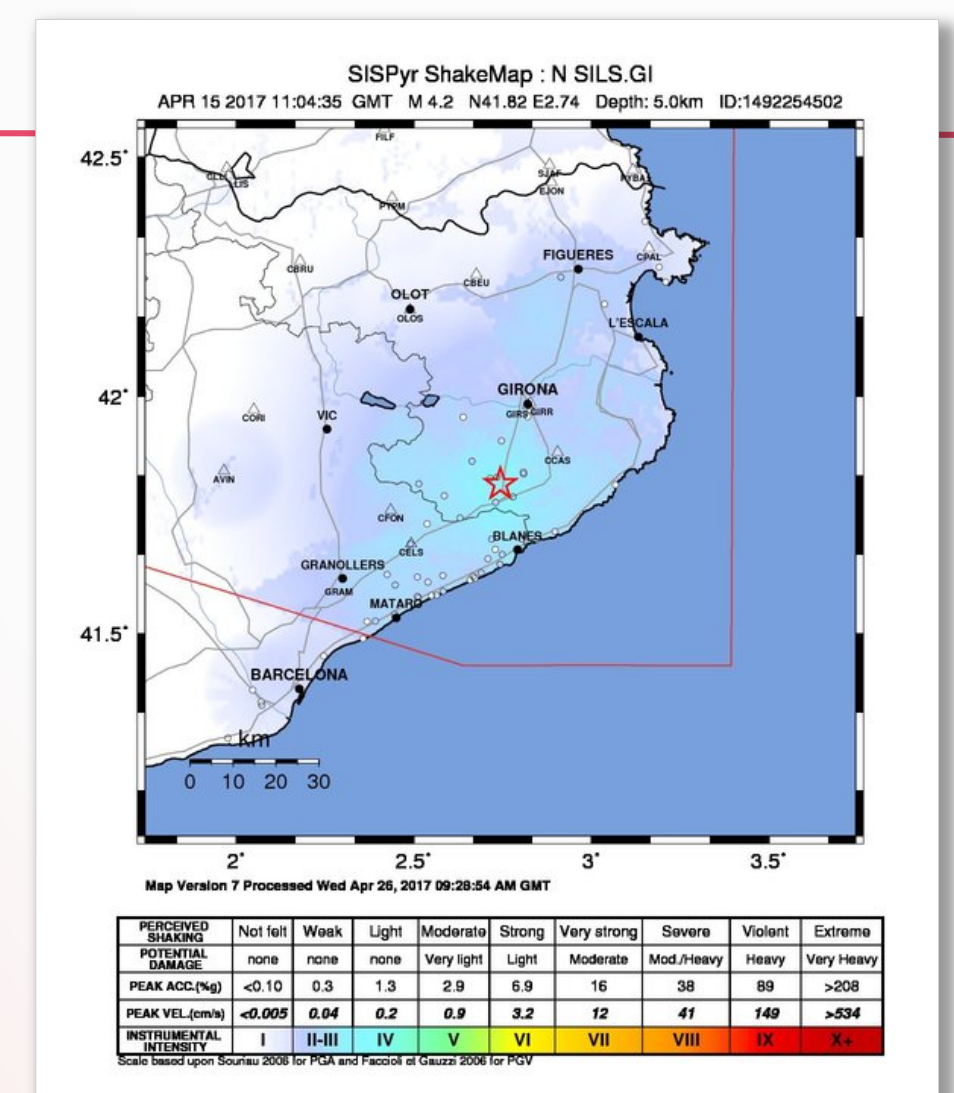
- **Encourage a common culture of seismic risk** in the Pyrenees (provide an harmonized evaluation of the seismic vulnerability and risk, share a common information)
- **Provide decision support tools for seismic crisis managers** on a cross-border area covering the Pyrenean regions of Catalonia in Spain, Occitania in France and Andorra.



Results

- **Automatic municipal level tool of the expected earthquake damages** to risk management actors
- **Smartphones applications for vulnerability assessment and post-seismic** to emergency managers
- **Guidelines for seismic vulnerability** to construction technicians and risk managers

Tools and guides for seismic risk management in Pyrenees will be transposable to **other cross-border areas or at an Euro-Mediterranean level**. All tools provided will be tested by cross-border emergency services during trainings and seismic crisis exercises.



Perspectives

Optimize and reinforce **for a major seismic event in Pyrenees: the capacity of anticipation and the potential response of crisis management services.**

POCRISC EFA158/16 project is 65% financed by the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) through the Interreg V-A Spain France Andorra program (POCTEFA 2014-2020). POCTEFA aims to reinforce the economic and social integration of the French-Spanish-Andorran border. Its support is focused on developing economic, social and environmental cross-border activities through joint strategies favoring sustainable territorial development.
